**REQUIREMENTS FOR FILING
 NOMINATION PAPERS**

Candidates are advised to seek legal counsel as to their qualifications for office, the proper method for completing the petition forms with respect to the office sought, the qualifications of the signators and circulators, as well as other mandatory requirements.

Election laws prescribe the forms to be submitted in seeking nomination to office. The DuPage County Election Commission has prepared suggested forms for Petitions, Statement of Candidacy and Loyalty Oath. The Statement of Economic Interests form is available from and must be **filed** with the **DuPage County Clerks' Office**.

Petition sheets may not be circulated more than 90 days preceding the last day to file.
